



TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONTRACTING OF AIR CONDITIONER EQUIPEMENT SUPPLIES

1. PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT

FIIAPP F.S.P. requires the contracting of supplies associated with the equipment of Air Conditioners for the project "Action Against Trafficking in Persons and Smuggling of Migrants in Nigeria" (A-TIPSOM NIGERIA).

FIIAPP F.S.P. reserves the right of request additional products of the same typology and/or different amounts of the one described in this Administrative Specifications, to meet the needs of A-TIPSOM project.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

It is required the contracting of supplies associated with the equipment of an Air Conditioners. Also, FIIAPP F.S.P. requires:

- Produce a high-quality work according to the specifications of the FIIAPP, F.S.P.
- Deliver the final products to the specify destinies in Abuja. The specified address will set up once the contract will be signed.
- Provide two warranty year per item (Industrial Air Conditioners and Split Air Conditioners)
- Installation of the Industrial Air Conditioners guaranteeing its proper functioning

Ensure the adequate reception of the final products in their destinations and agreed times always assuming the relative and derived costs of the shipment and of the transport.

These contracts present a general vision of the types of products that will be deliver to A-TIPSOM. Those could vary in its specifications depending on the needs of the project.

The delivery of the products will be in two different locations of Abuja, Nigeria. The awarded company is committed to deliver them on term, and will take the responsibility for the delay, in which case the Art. 193 of the LCSP will be applied.

Performance of the contract will comply with the conditions detailed in the Particular Administrative Conditions and the Technical Specifications, which are contractual in nature, wherefore they must be signed by the successful bidder in witness whereof, in the same act of formally executing the contract.

3.CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH WHEN PROVIDING THE SERVICE

1. Bids:



Interested parties will submit bids according to the conditions set forth in the administrative specifications, in the proper manner and form, for translation and interpretation services.

2. Specifications:

- Produce a high-quality work according to the specifications of the FIIAPP, F.S.P.
- Send the final products to the specify destinies in Abuja. The specified address will set up once the contract will be signed.
- Provide two warranty year per item (Industrial Air Conditioners and Split Air Conditioners).
- Installation of the Industrial Air Conditioners guaranteeing its proper functioning

3. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional services are considered those that may be derived from the free provision or allocation, by the tenderer, of services pertaining to the purpose of the contracting, as long as they can be financially assessed and are related to and directly useful for developing the purpose of the contract.

The following table shows the minimum technical conditions of the products, which represent the initial demand (extensible according to the needs of the project):

4. DELIVERY AND BILLING

Deliver the final products to the specify destinies in Abuja. The specified address will set up once the contract will be signed. The successful company undertakes to comply with the agreed delivery period, for each job, therefore assuming the liability in the event of a delay.

All material must be properly packaged, palletised, referenced and labelled to be delivered to the beneficiary institution in Abuja.

Payment will be made by bank transfer within a period of no more than thirty days as from the date when an invoice is submitted.
